

Incident Response and Crisis Management Training Exercise

How well is your company, employees, and community prepared for an active shooter incident? This interactive training exercise gives your employees the tools to respond and stay safe when faced with an emergency or threat in the office.

Length: 6 hours

Delivery: In-person, interactive active threat simulations

Audience: Employees, internal and external security personnel, and local first responders

Tomahawk's unique training approach includes employees, company leaders, security personnel, and local first responders to ensure cohesion and partnership in their response and protocols. In this training, participants will:

- · Take part in hands-on, active threat realistic scenarios
- Evaluate and improve responses
- Become familiar with office protocols, which is especially important for first responders who aren't familiar with your building

Exercise Timeline

Pre-Exercise

- 12 weeks of planning with relevant corporate and Tomahawk project managers.
- · Site visit by Tomahawk representatives approximately 8 weeks prior to the exercise to conduct a walkthrough.
- · Liaison with first responders.

Exercise

- The Tomahawk team establishes a secure and safe training environment.
- Participants receive a thorough exercise safety brief; safety is paramount!
- If associate volunteers are participating, Tomahawk delivers its active threat training prior to the role-playing scenarios
- The exercise consists of two scenarios, custom designed based on the corporate location, its operating environment, its capabilities, and leadership goals.
- All participants take part in the post-scenario debrief.

Post-Exercise

- Your company receives valuable feedback from our team, including an Executive Summary with evaluations and recommendations. You'll receive:
 - · An evaluation of the security team and the effective integration of first responder response
 - · Steps to take to improve security systems, communication protocol, and crisis management processes
