How do I register for Tomahawk Institute courses?

You'll find information on our public website: TomahawkInstitute.com. To register groups, you can work with a Tomahawk client manager or Institute sales manager. There is an MOQ of 12 licenses; yet there is no maximum. A typical license period is one year from the date of purchase.

How do I access my content?

Tomahawk maintains its own Learning Management System (LMS). Once you're registered, you can sign into the Institute to access your assigned content on a learner dashboard. You can consume all content online, and the vast majority on any mobile device, using our mobile app.

What other methods of delivery are available?

If you have your own LMS, Tomahawk can deliver content via a secure file transfer protocol. We typically utilize SCORM or xAPI.

How does the Tomahawk Institute support in-person training?

Many of our online offerings either complement live trainings or provide the same information for those unable to attend in person. Courses in active threat training, de-escalation, situational awareness, and several law enforcement disciplines are popular pairings for in-person trainings. Certain courses carry certificates of completion and satisfy continuing education requirements for our public safety partners.

Do you have any courses available for the general public?

Yes! Our foundational training, [Active Threat: Baseline](#), teaches the basics for an active threat response. It was filmed in a public setting, but its lessons apply to any situation and location.
